Business centers of O1 Properties hold New Year charity campaign for children

Moscow, Russia. December 6, 2016. Investment company O1 Properties, one of the largest owners of class A office real estate in Moscow, is holding its third annual campaign, *Give Happiness at New Year*, collecting gifts for seriously ill children and children at risk. Three Russian charities, Podsolnukh ("Sunflower"), Arifmetika Dobra ("Arithmetic of Goodness") and Vera ("Faith") are O1's partners in this year's campaign.

The *Give Happiness* campaign runs from 6 to 19 December 2016 at the White Square, Ducat Place III, White Stone, Bolshevik, Legenda, Lighthouse, Stanislavsky Factory, Krugozor, Silver City and LeFORT business centers. The centers are divided into 5 groups, each collecting gifts for a program of one of the partner charities. The gifts include children's toys, creative kits, computer equipment and sweets. Vera's volunteers will send the gifts all around Russia, together with vital medical equipment and other care items. The Give Happiness at New Year campaign of O1 Properties is being held in 2016 for the third consecutive year. About 2000 gifts were collected in 2014-2015 for the Miloserdiye ("Mercy") charity. The charity provides vital and costly treatment to children under 18 who suffer from primary immunodeficiency and autoimmune diseases. Podsolnukh currently helps more than 600 children in all regions of Russia.
